### Exclusion

*Disciplinary action will be taken where a student fails to meet the requirements of the school. Gross misconduct will result in immediate exclusion. This includes:*

- Not following UKVI visa regulations
- Stealing Avalon or another student's property
- Carrying or taking illegal substances such as drugs
- Carrying an illegal or offensive weapon such as a knife
- Being repeatedly offensive, abusive, drunk or violent
- Putting staff or students at risk
- Assaulting or threatening a student or member of staff
